What's in a book?

Leviticus

The instructions from the Lord to Moses with what is called the Mosaic Law. These list the ritual, legal, and moral practices that would govern the life of the Israelites. The name of the book derives from the name of Levi, one of the sons of Jacob whose tribe were given special care of the Tabernacle.

Numbers

This book records the wanderings of the Israelites in the desert following the giving of the Ten Commandments. It ends with the death of Moses as they are poised to enter the promised Land. The name refers to the two times of Census. The first around two years after leaving Egypt [Numbers 1:] with the second some thirty eight years later [Numbers 26:]

Deuteronomy

This book contains three speeches by Moses reminding the Israelites of the previous forty years and a reminder to them to follow the LORD and observe His commands. Moses then commissions Joshua to lead the Israelites into the Promised Land.
