Focus on Burkina Faso Share the load this Harvest

Our Harvest theme for this year is provided by Tearfund with an emphasis on their work in Burkina Faso.

Those of you whose geography is limited to schooldays long past may well not know anything about the country. Originally the French Colony of Haute-Volta in inland West Africa it gained full independence in 1960 and received its present name in 1984. With an area of around 106,000 square miles, it is just larger than the United Kingdom and has a population of around 21½ million, an increase from 14 million in 2006. It is home to more than 60 ethnic groups with the local Mossi group representing 53% of the population. Just over one fifth of the population is Christian with three fifths following Islam. The country is land-locked and surrounded by 6 countries with Ouagadougou as its capital. Situated on an extensive plateau, its climate is generally sunny, hot and dry with rainfall patterns becoming more erratic through climate change. Around 90% of the population rely on subsistence agriculture or livestock raising.

Tearfund has been working in Burkina Faso for over fifty years with local partners and churches to help communities overcome poverty and reach their God given potential.
