The 19th Sunday after Trinity

Faithful Lord, whose steadfast love never ceases and whose mercies never come to an end: grant us the grace to trust you and to receive the gifts of your love, new every morning, in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Following on from last week's introduction to the Diocese Prayer Community, here are some thoughts from the Revd Justine Smith concerning the changes and challenges besetting us. This is particularly relevant considering all that is happening in the world and in our Parish. Peter was confident in God's love and guidance and we should be too. We can still be encouraged to "stand fast" in the "true grace of God".

1 Peter 5:10-12

And after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, support, strengthen, and establish you. To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen. Through Silvanus, whom I consider a faithful brother, I have written this short letter to encourage you, and to testify that this is the true grace of God. Stand fast in it.

The cyclical process of looking back, reassessing, and moving forward in a different way is not always easy, but it can be very worthwhile. This letter – 1 Peter – encourages people in hardship, and it encourages us that change is facilitated by God's power and grace. Let's stand fast in that grace and let God restore, support, strengthen and establish.
