Collect for the 25th Sunday after Trinity from the Book of Common Prayer STIR up, we beseech thee, O Lord, the wills of thy faithful people; that they, plenteously bringing forth the fruit of good works, may by thee be plenteously rewarded; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

The last of the long sequence of Sundays after Trinity is also seen as the last Sunday of the Chuch's Year. As we prepare to move into the solemn season of Advent, we are taking our first steps on the road to the Triumph of Easter. For many years, this Sunday has been called "Stir-up Sunday" from the first words of the Collect. It was hi-jacked by the Victorians as a reminder to 'stir up' their Christmas Puddings to give them time to mature.

To us it is an urge to renew our commitment to our Lord's final command to preach the Gospel to all nations. [Mark 16:15].

Our Common Worship Book identifies this Sunday as the **Festival of Christ the King**. Even though we celebrate week by week, we are forcibly reminded today of Christ as our Glorified Lord and King. It deepens our awareness of Christ on the Cross, His Resurrection and his triumphant return which is to come. We are made ready for the season of Advent where we focus on Christ's triumphal return and prepare for the celebration of God's ultimate revelation of Himself in the birth of His Son into our world.
