CPAS is one of the Societies we support from the tithe on our Church's income. They work with churches mainly in the UK and Republic of Ireland in support of evangelism. Their work covers young people through Ventures and Falcons, developing parish missional leadership and acting as Patrons to many parishes including ours.

For Summer 2020 they had seventy-seven residential events scheduled across the country for children and young people from eight to eighteen. These have had to be cancelled with non-recoverable losses of over £150,000. On a positive note they have developed Virtual Ventures which have allowed their members to interact online by squeezing fun, faith and fellowship through the Internet

MISSION SUPPORT 2020

Every year Darfield All Saints Church 'tithes' its income from planned giving from members of the congregation. This means that it gives 10% of that income to missions or charities. For a number of years now we have made the practice of choosing four such missions to support each year. This year the missions are CPAS, Release International, Scripture Union and The Bible Society. We have now sent £875 to each of those four missions this year.

Tempting as it is to hang on to money in these uncertain times (just in case), we realise that these missions are just as much in need of the money as we are, if not more so. The amount that we send this year is actually 10% of the planned giving that we received last year – so is not affected by our reduction in income due to coronavirus.

We have already received thanks from three of the four.

Scripture Union will be sending a full thank you letter but in the meantime wanted me to pass on their heartfelt thanks for our money and prayers.

CPAS have said "In these unusual and challenging times we appreciate your support more than ever. We thank God for all your kindness and generosity to our work - with every blessing to you also in these challenging times".

Release International have said "Thank you so much for your generous gift from your church. We really appreciate your faithful support including your prayers. It is because of the kindness and prayers of friends like you that we can support prisoners of faith and their families practically and pastorally so they know they are not forgotten. Thank you for your church family's care for our brothers and sisters."
