Release International Voice of Persecuted Christians



Release International works through local Church partners in more than 25 countries helping persecuted Christians prayerfully, pastorally and practically.

Oppression and discrimination against Christians have increased during Covid. Many Christians have been denied food and relief and are abandoned by families because of their faith.

In Eritrea those fleeing persecution have been barred from refugee camps and are unable to gain support from UN-HCR, the United Nations' relief agency. Release International Partners in Eritrea are providing food parcels for some of these families
