Remembrance 2020.

They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old: Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning We will remember them.

These words were written in September 1914 by Robert Laurence Binyon, CH, as his response to the extremely large number of casualties inflicted on the British Expeditionary Force in the first two months of the First World War.

They have become a major part of our Act of Remembrance for all those who died during the Two World Wars and in other conflicts since then.

Commemorative events scheduled to mark the 75th Anniversaries of VE Day, the end of the war in Europe in May and VJ Day, the end of the war against Japan in August had to be cancelled and our Remembrance Sunday Service will take on a different format. We will not be able to gather as we have usually done in our churches and at our War Memorials.

Wherever we are at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday 8^{th} November and Wednesday 11^{th} November, let us pause and keep silence as we remember all those whose names are inscribed on the War Memorials across our Parish, Mission Area, Diocese, country and beyond.

When You Go Home, Tell Them of Us And Say, For Your Tomorrow, We Gave Our Today.

The **Royal British Legion** was established in 1921 to serve the needs of servicemen and women and their families throughout their Service career and afterwards. Their work of life-long support has continued throughout this strange year.

The **Battle Back Centre** in Lilleshall has programmes to enable the best possible recovery for wounded, injured and sick Service Personnel whether returning to service or transitioning into life as a civilian. Normally one half of our open collection on Remembrance Sunday is sent to the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal. This will not be possible this year. Also, you may not have been able to contribute directly through the Poppy Sellers.
