# **The 18th Sunday after Trinity**

God, our judge and saviour, teach us to be open to your truth and to trust in your love, that we may live each day with confidence in the salvation which is given through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Quite some time ago the Diocese of Sheffield created a Prayer Community. You commit to a number of daily acts designed to Renew, Rejuvenate and Release your faith. The idea is that you "sign up" to commit to certain daily actions & the Diocese send weekly emails with inspirational thoughts and resources. We therefore maintain as a first priority a real reliance on the Spirit of God in prayer and worship and in the consecration of our lives, as individuals and communities. But it occurred to me recently that there is no need to be "online" to take part in this Community and feel the power of prayer in our lives. I would imagine that many of you follow these commitments as a matter of course anyway, but here's what's involved;

- 1. Say the Lord's Prayer daily;
- 2. Read at least one verse of the Bible every day;
- 3. Say the Diocesan Vision Prayer daily; and
- 4. Pause daily before God at 20.25 to seek the renewing power of God's Spirit
