Waiting...

The tune to the well known Christmas Carol was adopted by troops who were often forced into situations where they had to «Hurry up and wait». Their chorus of «Why are we waiting» would show their frustration in these situations.

What are we waiting for? We could all make our own lists. The Church's season of Advent is a time of waiting but also of preparation. The Psalms include many references to waiting including "We wait in hope for the Lord; He is our help and our shield." [Psalm 33: 20]. The Old Testament Prophets were waiting for the Messiah, the Anointed One, who would redeem Israel. "I will wait for the God of my Salvation" [Micah 7: 7]

Simeon was waiting for **the Consolation of Israel** [St Luke 2: 25] with a promise that he would see the Lord's Christ before he died. That promise was fulfilled. [St Luke 2: 27–35]

Zechariah was visited by the Angel Gabriel to announce that his wife Elizabeth was to bear a child who would "bring back many of the people of Israel to the Lord their God" [St Luke 1: 16]. The people were waiting outside the Temple for Zechariah [St Luke 1: 21] and Zechariah himself had to wait until John was born and named to be able to speak again. Both John and Jesus had to wait around thirty years before God's time was right for their ministries to begin.

As we prepare to celebrate Christmas in whatever way we are able to do, let us not forget that we need to prepare for Jesus to return. We do not know when that will be [Acts 1: 7] but we have the promise of Jesus that it will happen! [St Matthew 24:]
