Whoever has ears, let them hear.' The Parable of the Sower [St Matthew 13: 3-9; 18-23]

The farmer described in this Parable experienced a variable response to his seed-sowing with only a small fraction surviving and growing into mature plants to produce a crop.

The Parable itself was directed at the large crowd which had gathered to hear Jesus. As with the majority of the other Parables, Jesus gave the explanations only to the small group of disciples who were with him. There seems to be no record in the Gospels as to how many of the listeners became disciples as they responded to their individual call from Jesus.

We will find these same variable responses to our attempts at evangelism but bear in mind two additional thoughts. The response to a seed being sown is not instantaneous as the gardeners among us will verify, and the 'good ground' would have needed preparation and regular maintenance throughout the growing season.

We should always be looking for opportunities to share our faith but not be discouraged when our time scale does not match God's time scale for the individuals we seek to bring to faith in Jesus.
