Separation and a Season to remember...

The few days between All Saints Day and Remembrance Sunday have come to be seen as a time when we can pause and remember. On All Saints Day we remember the countless Saints, both known and unknown who faithfully served their Lord throughout the centuries.

This weekend the focus changes as we remember those who enlisted as volunteers or conscripts in the service of their country during the dark times of two World Wars and in the many conflicts before and since. We can perhaps visualise the rows of over 300,000 simple white gravestones in over 13,000 cemeteries across the world and in our own Churchyard. What is harder to visualise is the lasting effects that many of the returnees suffered. They had endured a separation from their homes and families, some for periods of years, and many found it difficult to adjust on their return to their ordinary lives. In 1939, over 1.5 million people including 800,000 children were separated from their families and evacuated to towns and villages in the countryside from their homes in the larger cities which were seen as, and did become, targets for bombing.

Jacob had worked for Laban, his father-in-law, for many years and had married Laban's daughters Leah and Rachel. When Jacob eventually left with all his family and possessions to return to Canaan, Laban sent him off with the words

"May the LORD keep watch between you and me when we are away from each other." [Genesis 31: 49]. We live in a different relationship with our Lord with the promise...

"Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? [Romans 8: 35]

They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old: Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning

We will remember them.
