Jesus said "I am..." Verses from St John's Gospel

Jesus offers a choice between the darkness of sin and the bright light of His presence

"I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness but will have the light of life" [8: 12].

The first verses of Genesis describe the initial acts of Creation with "darkness upon the face of the deep". God said, "Let there be Light" [Gen 1: 3]. We know from the first Chapter of St John's Gospel that the Word, Jesus, was with God at the beginning and that "In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." [1: 4-5]

Jesus alone offers us the path to Salvation.

"I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture" [10: 9].

In the Parable of the Lost Sheep [St Luke 15: 3-7] we see the nature of sheep to stray and with their total lack of homing instinct frequently becoming separated from their flock. The door to the sheepfold was a help to the sheepherd enabling them to watch over their sheep.

Christ died to save us all

"I am the Good Shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep" [10: 11].

It was common for hired shepherds to desert their post when danger threatened. Jesus describes His forthcoming death and resurrection to save us, His sheep.

Jesus has promised to raise all who believe in Him

"I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live" [11: 25].

These words are said to Martha following the death of her brother Lazarus. Martha confesses that she believes in the Resurrection and that Jesus is the Messiah

Jesus is God and our only route to salvation

"I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me" [14: 6].

The disciples were with Jesus celebrating what was to be their last meal together. Over the past months, Jesus had tried to explain to them his chosen path to death and resurrection without much success. This explanation is in response to a question from Thomas, "Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?" [St John 14: 5]

Jesus is the source of our life for today and for ever.

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser" [15: 1]

The fruit of any plant, in whatever form, relies on the stems or branches and the skills of the gardener or farmer to ripen. Vineyards were a common sight in the area at that time.
