Spotlight on the Apostles: Matthias: Acts 1: 15-26: 14th May:

In the few days between Ascension and Pentecost, the eleven disciples and others were devoting themselves to prayer. With reference to Psalm 109: 8, "May his days be few; may another take his place of leadership", Peter proposed that another should take the place of Judas Iscariot in the Twelve. They decided that one of those who had been with the group since the Baptism of Jesus should join them as a **Witness of His Resurrection** [Acts 1: 21-23].

Two names emerged as candidates; Joseph Barsabbas surnamed Justus, and Matthias. After earnest prayer to discern the will of the Lord, their lots were cast and Matthias was duly enrolled with the eleven apostles. The Bible tells us no more than this but we can presume that he received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost with the others and went on to spread the Gospel.

Lights for Christ:

A personal rule of life acts as a framework to release each one of us to become more Christ-like.

It should be our grateful response to God's love and grace.

Focus on Mission: **ICS**

The Intercontinental Church Society works with English speaking congregations across the globe supporting resident Chaplains in 65 established churches in Europe, North Africa, South America and the South Atlantic and resort ministry in Europe and the Mediterranean.

In 2020, all the Summer Resort Ministries had to be cancelled. The English Church of St Peter in Zermatt, Switzerland was opened in 1870. They hope to celebrate their 151st Anniversary in June 2021, having had to postpone their 150th Anniversary in 2020.

Resort Chaplains usually serve the local community and the summer and winter visitors for 8 months of the year.
