A busy time: St Mark 6: 30-56:

Jesus and His disciples had moved on from Nazareth into the surrounding country. The disciples had been sent out and had been able, with the authority of Jesus, to cast out demons and heal many people [Mark 6: 12-13]. As the disciples returned with the news of what they had done, the crowds were gathering and following Jesus and His disciples as they tried to find a quiet place to rest.

All four Gospels describe the way in which Jesus provided for the crowd's material needs, at this point numbering 5,000, who seemingly had made no provision for being out on a hillside, away from the towns and villages, at a mealtime. Only the account in St John's Gospel identifies "a lad" as the source of the five barley loaves and two fish [St John 6: 9]. When the disciples had been tested by being told to "give them something to eat" they had as was generally the case, missed the miraculous ability of Jesus to solve the problem. The disciples estimated 200 denarii as the cost of buying food. The denarius was a Roman silver coin, typically the daily wage for a labourer at the time [St Matt: 20:2]. Such was the scale of the miracle that they were able to collect twelve baskets of remains.

Even as they crossed the Sea of Galilee to Gennesaret, the crowds continued to gather and brought sick people to Jesus for healing.

During this time, Jesus had continued to teach the crowds many things.

Jesus made many references to shepherds and sheep in His teachings and as recorded in St John's Gospel, described Himself as "**The Good Shepherd**" [St John 10:11,14]. Jesus identified the local religious leaders as being ineffective and described the people as being like "**sheep without a shepherd**" [St Mark 6: 24]
