The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few...

When Jesus began His earthly ministry, it was over 450 years since Malachi, the last of the Israelite Prophets, had spoken words of encouragement from the LORD. In the meantime the various groups of religious leaders had taken the Laws given to Moses by the LORD as related in the Book of Exodus and added a large number of ritualistic extras to the basic Law. This had a distinct effect on most of the people and Jesus described the crowds that were following Him and His disciples as being "harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd." [Matthew 9: 36]. Jesus continued by proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. [Matthew 9:35];

Jesus then sent the twelve disciples out into the local communities with power to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness. [Matthew 10: 1, 5]. The disciples were successful and called many people to repentance and performed acts of healing [Mark 6: 12, 13]

Malachi's final prophetic words include a reference to the return of Elijah to turn "the hearts of the parents to their children, and the hearts of the children to their parents" [Malachi 4: 5,6]. Following the death of John the Baptist, some of the people had thought that John was linked to Elijah which was confirmed by Jesus "for those willing to accept it, that John is the Elijah who was to come." [Matthew] 11: 15]

Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field [Matthew 9: 38]
