Prayer: Read 1 Timothy 2: 1-7

Our dictionaries tell us that an intercession is an act of praying on behalf of oneself or others.

Paul had met Timothy in Lystra in Asia Minor on his second missionary journey. Timothy's mother, Eunice, and grandmother, Lois, were Jewish converts to Christianity and had given Timothy a grounding in the faith. [2 Timothy 1: 5]. Timothy had joined Paul on some of his later journeys. We have two letters which Paul wrote to Timothy which, along with one to Titus are called the Pastoral Epistles. In this first letter Timothy received guidance and instruction on the organisation of the Church.

Paul urged Timothy that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people; for kings and all those in authority. [1 Timothy 2: 1,2]

If we look back at the pattern of prayer established by Jesus [Matthew 6: 9-13] we can see a framework for Prayer which can guide the way we pray.

Through prayers of petition, we seek forgiveness from our Lord for everything that keeps us from Him. Our intercessions are prayers for others and the world in which we live. Our prayers of thanksgiving recognise what we receive, our life and health, our families and faith.

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. [Philippians 4: 6]
