The road to Bethlehem begins...

My soul doth magnify the Lord and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour. For He hath regarded the lowliness of His handmaiden. [BCP]

The Angel Gabriel was given two missions just a few months apart. A visit to Zechariah to announce the birth of John the Baptist and to Mary to announce the birth of Jesus. Both recipients were amazed. Zechariah was dubious because of his and his wife Elizabeth's ages. [St Luke 1: 18]. Mary was initially 'greatly troubled' [St Luke 1:29] but was reassured by Gabriel who also told her of Elizabeth's news.

Since she and Elizabeth were related, Mary quickly arranged to visit Elizabeth. On Mary's arrival, both Elizabeth and her unborn child reacted [St Luke 1:41]. Elizabeth's words "Blessed are you among women and blessed is the child you will bear! " [St Luke 1: 42] have been used for centuries as a form of devotion and a penance.

Mary's response [St Luke 1: 46-55], is included as the Magnificat in Evening Prayer in the Book of Common Prayer. In its Latin form the first line is "Magnificat ánima mea Dóminum." My soul doth magnify the Lord".

Mary remained with Elizabeth for three months before returning to her home. A few months later, the Census called by Caesar Augustus took Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem to fulfil the prophesy of Micah [Micah 5: 2]

"But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times."
