# **Electoral Roll: Closing Date for applications—Sunday 5th March 2023**

As part of the preparations for the Annual Parochial Church Meeting [APCM], your PCC has to revise the Parish Electoral Roll. Only members of the Electoral Roll can vote at the APCM for members of the Deanery Synod and Parochial Church Council. **If you are already on the Electoral Roll then you need to do nothing.** 

To qualify you need to be over 16 and baptised, and satisfy one of three conditions.

- 1. You live in the Parish and are a member of the Church of England
- 2. You are a member of the Church of England or a Church in Communion with the Church of England, not resident in the Parish but have habitually attended public worship during the preceding six months.
- 3. You are of good standing in a Church which is not in communion with the Church of England but which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and are also a member of the Church of England and habitually attended public worship in the parish during the preceding six months.

Application Forms are available in our Churches and must be returned by <u>Sunday 5th March 2023</u> to take effect for this year's meeting on 26th March 2023.

Your data will be stored in line with the UK General Data Protection Regulations as set out in the Data Protection Act, 2018.

### A Prayer for Growth:


Lord Jesus, as a Church Family in All Saints' and St Michael's, it is our mission to know You and proclaim You.

**Transfiguration:** a complete change of form or appearance

In his second letter 'To those who through the righteousness of our God and Saviour Jesus Christ have received a faith as precious as ours:' [2] Peter 1: 1], Peter remembers a time when, with James and John, he was an eyewitnesses to a significant event in the ministry of Jesus. [2 Peter 1: 17-18]

Jesus had been explaining to His Disciples that he was heading for Jerusalem for a confrontation with the Religious Leaders which would result in His death and, on the third day, His Resurrection.

Six days after this revelation, Jesus took Peter, James and John up a mountain where He was transfigured in front of them. His face shone as the Sun and His clothes became white as the light [St Matthew 17: 2] In addition the disciples saw the figures of Moses and Elijah who were talking with Jesus.

As a bright cloud covered them all, they heard a voice from the cloud saying, "This is my Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased. Listen to Him!" [St Matthew 17: 5]. On the way back down the mountain the disciples were told not to tell anyone of what they had seen, until after the Resurrection.

Both Moses and Elijah had had mountain top experiences with the LORD. On Mount Sinai, Moses received the Ten Commandments inscribed on tablets of stone. [Exodus 24: 12]. Elijah had fled from the wrath of Queen Jezebel to a cave on Mount Horeb where he received encouragement and instructions. [1 Kings 19: 8, 12-13]

#### Psalm 99: 2,3,9

- 2 Great is the LORD in Zion: he is exalted over all the nations.
- 3 Let them praise your great and awesome name - he is holy.
- 9 Exalt the LORD our God and worship at his holy mountain, for the LORD our God is holy.
