## LyCiG — Leading your Church into Growth

What do we talk about the most? The weather, sports teams, pop idols, church buildings, money, lack of volunteers? What is missing from this list, or should we really ask **who** is missing?

What did the disciples do in the days after Pentecost? "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." [Acts 2: 42]. We read that on the Day of Pentecost alone about 3,000 were added to their number [Acts 2: 41].

At the first of our LyCiG sessions this week, we were reminded of Nehemiah who was a cup bearer to King Artaxerxes of Babylon and one of the exiled Israelites. He was saddened when he heard of the sorry state of the city and Temple of Jerusalem, and of those who had escaped captivity. He gained permission from the King to return to Jerusalem to rebuild the city and Temple. Nehemiah. He was able to implement the plan the LORD had given him, and work soon started. [Nehemiah 1: & 2:].

Nehemiah had a bit of physical help in the work as the list of names in chapter 3 indicates!

As a first step to consider - What is our vision for the people in our parish, and for growth, both spiritually and numerically, in our congregations?

We need to pray but how can we pray effectively? One step would be to join us at our monthly prayer meeting on **Monday 4th July at 8:00 p.m..** 

Even working together, we cannot do everything in our own strength. We need the strength of the Lord and the power of the Spirit to bring our vision to fruition.
