The Transfiguration. The Law and the Prophets

The **Law and the Prophets** was a term used at the time of Christ to describe the Hebrew Scriptures, what we know as the Old Testament. **The Law** refers to the Torah or Pentateuch, the first five books, whilst **The Prophets** refers to the rest of the Old Testament even though the link in some cases is not immediately obvious. In the Sermon on the Mount [Matthew 5: 17], Jesus uses the term as He describes His purpose to fulfil the teachings of the Old Testament rather than to destroy them.

Following the Feeding of the Five Thousand, Jesus quizzed His disciples initially as to who the crowds thought He was and then what they thought. The ultimate answer came from Peter, "You are God's Messiah" [Luke 9: 20]. Jesus then went on to describe the events which would lead up to His death and Resurrection. It was to be after the events of the first Easter Sunday that the disciples realised the true significance.

A few days later, Jesus took Peter, James and John to a mountain to pray. Whilst on the mountain the face of Jesus changed and his clothes took on a dazzling appearance. Two men appeared and talked with Jesus about His departure to Jerusalem. They were identifiable as Moses representing The Law and Elijah representing The Prophets. Peter is roused from partial slumber and as the two men make to leave suggests putting up three shelters probably to prolong the encounter. Not for the first, or last time, Peter, despite his earlier revelation failed to realise the significance of what he had witnessed. "He did not know what he was saying" [Luke 9: 33]. Before Peter had completed his words, a cloud appeared and covered them all. From the cloud the voice of God completed the encounter by saying

"This is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to him." We should follow that command.
