

Monday 25th April: Funeral: Keith Race aged 74:

St Michael's Great Houghton and Great Houghton Cemetery

One hundred and fifty-three fish



[St John 21: 1-14]

The Sea of Galilee had an abundance of fish and would have supported many fisher families. Following the Resurrection, some of the Disciples had returned to their home area around the Sea of Galilee. Peter decided to return to what he knew best - fishing. With the other disciples he spent a fruitless night in the boat. Early in the morning, they saw a man near the shore who asked whether they had caught any fish. Following their negative answer, he told them to cast their nets once more. The miraculous catch revealed the man as the Risen Jesus. He then prepared breakfast for the Disciples.
