No Service today at Gt Houghton 10:45 a.m. Service for Sunday, Darfield 4:00 p.m. The Well Darfield Church Hall


We welcomed around 55 adults and 25 Children to our **Snowdrop Event** and received donations of £167.

A Family Reconciled: Genesis 45:

Joseph was the eleventh of the twelve sons of Jacob. He grew up as his father's favourite which led to so much ill-feeling that his brothers plotted to kill Joseph. However reason prevailed and they sold Joseph ultimately into slavery in Egypt. His master, Potiphar, Captain of Pharoah's Guard, saw that the Lord was with Joseph and put him in charge of his household. However false accusations from Potiphar's wife put Joseph in prison, but once again he was put in charge of the prisoners as his devotion to the Lord was evident.

One of Joseph's gifts form the Lord was the interpretation of dreams. Joseph came to the attention of Pharoah when his advisors failed to give an interpretation of two of Pharoah's dreams. Joseph was given an explanation by the Lord that there were to be seven years of plenty followed by seven years of famine. Pharoah was moved by Joseph's devotion to the Lord and put him in charge to plan and store up grain ready for the famine.

The famine duly came and many from the surrounding lands travelled to Egypt to buy grain. This included Joseph's brothers who didn't recognise Joseph in their several encounters. Eventually Joseph revealed himself to his brothers. Pharoah invited Jacob and his whole family, then numbering seventy, to live in the best part of the Land of Egypt. They settled and prospered until a "Pharoah that knew not Joseph" [Exodus 1:8] set in motion the chain of events which were to bring the Israelites to the Promised Land in Canaan.

Joseph bore no resentment to his brothers as he realised the it was "to save lives that God sent me ahead of you." [Genesis 45: 5]

The full account of Joseph's devotion to the LORD is found in chapters 37 to 50
