Stir up, O Lord, the wills of Thy faithful people; that they, plenteously bringing forth the fruit of good works, may by Thee be plenteously rewarded; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Collect for the Sunday next before Advent [BCP]

This Sunday has significance in that it has several names on our liturgical calendar. To those familiar with the Book of Common Prayer, it is described as the 25<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Trinity with a note that the Collect, Epistle and Gospel must be used on the Sunday next before Advent. This Collect leads us to a more familiar name of Stir up Sunday. We are exhorted to stir up our wills, bring forth the fruit of good works and to receive our reward. In common usage this Sunday was the traditional day by which Christmas pudding had to be made so that they could mature over the following weeks to be at their best on Christmas Day. Early recipes for the pudding would include thirteen ingredients, said to represent Jesus and his disciples. The pudding had to be stirred, usually by all members of the family, in an east to west direction to honour the visit of the Magi to the infant Jesus. Some traditions included stirring small silver coins into the mixture to bring health, wealth and happiness to the finder.

More recently the Feast of Christ the King has been celebrated on this last Sunday of the Church year. Instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI, the celebration has spread and is now incorporated in our Common Worship.

Next week on Advent Sunday we will start the new Church year by looking forward to Christ's first coming into this world. Today reminds us of the promise that, at the end of time as we know it, Christ's Kingdom will be established.

The majority of the garden has now been cleared with the next phase set to vreate paths around the beds.


The funding for the project has to be matched through the involvement of volunteers. Next date not yet finalised but be prepared to come along and work, encourage or even just make the team a cuppa...
