Waiting:

How do we cope with waiting? Whether it is in the supermarket or a bus queue, or for your next birthday or more particularly for potentially life-changing events, we have to cope with the anxieties involved. We should be able to recall some of the occasions when the disciples were waiting for Jesus. For instance, in the Garden of Gethsemane on the evening of His arrest, Jesus went away from the disciples to pray, urging them to "Pray that you will not fall into temptation." St Luke 22: 40]. Their response was to be found sleeping when Jesus returned. [St Luke 22: 45]

Following the Ascension, the disciples returned to Jerusalem with great joy. [St Luke 24: 52]. Jesus had told them to remain there until the promised helper in the form of the Holy Spirit would come to them. Immediately after the Resurrection the disciples had been hiding behind locked doors for fear of the Jews [St John 20: 19]. Now they were continually at the temple, praising God. [St Luke 24: 53] What a difference their time with the risen Lord had made!

But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength;

They shall mount up with wings like eagles,

[Isaiah 40: 33]
