Focus on the Apostles: St Simon & St Jude: October 28th

In the list of the first Disciples in his Gospel and in the Acts of the Apostles, St Luke allocates the tenth and eleventh places to Simon the Zealot and Judas son of James. [Luke 6: 15-16]. In the Gospels of St Matthew and St Mark, the same list refers to Thaddeus and Simon the Zealot. It was not unusual at that time for people to be known by different names and Thaddeus is identified with Simon the Zealot. As with some of the other lesser-known Disciples, we only read that Simon was one of the original twelve and was with the rest of the Disciples in Jerusalem after the Ascension. [Acts 1: 13].

Judas the son of James, or Jude as we now know him, was definitely present at the Last Supper. Described as "Judas (not Iscariot)", [John 14: 22], he asks Jesus "Lord, how is it that You will manifest Yourself to us, and not to the world?" It's worth reading the lengthy reply that Jesus gave to Judas [John 14: 25 – 28]. The reply includes the wonderful promise of the Holy Spirit to help and guide us.

As one of the shortest books in our Bible at just 25 verses, the Epistle of Jude was written by Jude, the brother of James. Bible scholars have argued for centuries about the true identity of this writer but that pales into insignificance when you read the final verses.[Jude 1:24-25]

²⁴ To him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy— ²⁵ to the only God our Saviour be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages, now and for evermore! Amen.

Collect for St Simon and St Jude

O Almighty God, who hast built thy Church upon the foundation Of the Apostles and Prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the head corner-stone; Grant us so to be joined together in unity of spirit by their doctrine, that we may be made a holy temple acceptable unto thee; through the same Jesus Christ Our Lord.
