Our weekly giving is falling short, by **£60** per week, of the amount needed to balance our end of year account. Please read your leaflet and decide prayerfully how you can help.

Separation: The Sheep and the Goats:

[Matthew 25: 31-46]

When given a choice we often hear terms like separating the wheat from the chaff or the sheep from the goats. The Parable of the Sheep and goats is the last recorded Parable before the events of Thursday and Friday in what we know as Holy Week. It differs from most of the other Parables in that it describes the reality of the final Judgement. At this time, we see the Son of Man, Jesus, sitting on His glorious throne with all the nations gathered in front of Him. All will be directed to the right or left, the ones on the right described as sheep, are the righteous ones and will be blessed and taken into eternal life in the Heavenly Kingdom. Those to the left, the goats, are cursed and will be sent to eternal punishment.

Both groups are judged by their attitude to others in an allegory of their attitude to Jesus. The righteous, in helping the disadvantaged are deemed to have helped Jesus, the others in not helping them are deemed not to have helped Jesus.

Just take time to read or re-read the other sections of this news sheet to see where you can make a difference by giving some of your time to facilitate the warm space or support the Angel Bombing preparations. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men!" [Luke 2: 13,14]
