Clouds and Radiant Faces...

One of the dictionary definitions of the word **radiant** describes eyes or features beaming with joy, hope or love. Our Bible tells us of at least two linked occasions where faces were radiant in the presence of God revealed in a cloud.

Three months after the first Passover meal and their dramatic exit from slavery in Egypt, the Israelites reached the Sinai desert and camped near to Mount Sinai. [Exodus 19: 19]. The LORD called Moses from the mountain to spell out His Covenant or special relationship with the Israelites. The Israelites agreed to do everything the LORD had said and that they would become a holy nation and His treasured possession. [Exodus 19: 5]

Three days later, the Lord appeared in a cloud on the mountain and gave Moses what we know as the Ten Commandments [Exodus 20] and a whole series of further details and rules to govern their day to day and religious life [Exodus 21-33]

Moses spend forty days and nights on the mountain during which the resolve of the Israelites began to waver. Aaron, the brother of Moses, took over, collected gold jewellery from the people and made an idol in the shape of a calf. [Exodus 32: 4] The people then celebrated and sacrificed burnt offerings to the calf.

On his return from the mountain, Moses destroyed the calf and smashed the stones inscribed by the LORD with the Commandments. The consequences to the Israelites were great. [Exodus 32: 25-35].

The LORD called Moses back to Mount Sinai where he chiselled out two more stone tablets for the Lord to re-inscribe the commandments. When Moses returned from the mountain, he was not aware that his face was radiant because he had spoken with the Lord. [Exodus 34: 29]

Peter, James and John were among the earliest to commit themselves to follow Jesus and on several occasions were privileged to witness sights that the other Disciples did not see. One such occasion is described as the **Transfiguration** and came just a few days after Peter's confession that Jesus was the Messiah. [St Luke 9: 20] We find Peter, James and John being taken by Jesus to a mountain to pray. Whilst He was praying, the appearance of the face of Jesus changed and His clothes were bright as a flash of lightning. [St Luke 9: 29]. St Matthew records that "His face shone like the sun" [St Matthew 17: 2]. Jesus was joined by Moses, representing The Law, and Elijah representing The Prophets. The Law and the Prophets is a term often used to describe the Hebrew Bible or what we know as the Old Testament. Not for the first or last time the disciples were dozing but, on awakening, Peter suggests building three shelters. A cloud then appeared surrounding them from which the voice

of the Lord came... This is My Son, whom I have chosen; listen to Him [St Luke 9: 35]

We don't see a cloud when we meet with our Lord, but do our faces and lives shine as a result?
