Advent:

The new Church year has begun. The four Sundays leading up to Christmas give us time not only to prepare for our own Christmas but to remember that first Christ-mass in the Nativity.

The candles on our Advent Wreath will be lit week by week as a symbol of our wait with the fifth candle reserved for Christmas Day itself.

The name of Advent is derived from the Latin for coming. There is a deeper significance in this season in that we are waiting for Jesus to return in Glory. "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know the day or the hour." [St Matthew 25:13]

In the days before heading to Jerusalem, Jesus prepares his disciples for the events leading up to Calvary and beyond. He comforts them "And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am." [St John 14:3]

In today's Gospel reading Jesus describes the **«End Times»** and the earthly signs that will precede them. With many of these things occurring round about us today and all the pressures we feel, **"Stand firm, and you will win life"** [St Luke 21:0]

Our appeal last week has been successful. Our team is now double its former size! This sounds excellent, but in reality the team still has only


There is still a very great need to increase the numbers involved. More team members means that your time comes round less often.
