Advent Sunday

The word advent derives from the Latin meaning arrival and more particularly that of an important visitor. Our season of Advent reminds us of the most important Visitor to our World in history and in the future.

Advent is thus a season of preparation and expectation. We prepare to celebrate the Incarnation of Jesus in Bethlehem as the prelude to His life, preaching, death on a cross, Resurrection and

We are reminded that "this Jesus who was taken up from you into Heaven, will come in the same way as you saw Him go into Heaven" [Acts 1:11]

We must live in a state of alert watchfulness as we anticipate the return of Christ in Glory

sometime in the future at a day and time known only to God the Father.
Purple, the liturgical colour of Advent, in many ways matches our experience of this time of the year in the Northern Hemisphere where the hours of daylight get fewer as we move towards the shortest Day – the Winter Solstice, just before Christmas Day.

The tradition of lighted candles on our Advent display, imported from Northern Europe in the 19th Century is a symbol of the Light of the World as we use them to count down the Sundays in Advent before lighting the fifth candle on Christmas Day.

The hour has already come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So, let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armour of **light.** [Romans 13:11-12]
