A Response to Rejection. Mark 6: 1-13

Jesus had returned to
Nazareth with His disciples
and, as was His custom on
the Sabbath Day, had
entered the local
Synagogue. It was the
practice of the time that
anyone could read and give
their explanations of the
Scriptures.

The listeners were amazed by his wisdom but were blinkered by their memories of Jesus as a young boy and as the local carpenter. Such was their reaction that Jesus was amazed and was only able to heal a few sick people before moving on to the other settlements round about.

At this point the disciples were sent out in pairs with limited physical resources, a staff, sandals and the clothes they were wearing. They were reliant on the hospitality of the places they visited and, with the authority over impure spirits given to them by Jesus, were able to preach repentance, cast out demons and heal the sick. The disciples returned to Jesus and reported all that they had done and taught.
