Electoral Roll Revision 2023

Sunday 5th March is the last date on which names can be added to our Electoral Roll before our Annual Meetings. Forms are available in our Churches.

You need to be baptised and over 16, and a member of the Church of England living in the Parish.

If you live outside the Parish or are a member of another acceptable Church, you must have habitually attended services for at least six months.

Annual Parochial Meetings: 26th March 2023

Nominations [which must be proposed, seconded and agreed by the nominee] are invited for the elections at our Annual Parish Meeting and our Annual Parochial Church Meeting [APCM]

Nominations, may be made on the forms at the back of Church

Elections and appointments are conducted under the Church Representation Rules, 2020.

Churchwardens:

nominations for TWO Churchwardens

In addition a valid nomination form must be in the hands of the Chairman of the Annual Parish Meeting before the meeting starts.

Churchwardens are ex-officio members of the Parochial Church Council

Wath Deanery Synod:

nominations for THREE members of Deanery Synod

Deanery Synod representatives are ex-officio members of the Parochial Church Council and serve for a three year term.

The terms of office of Jo Darlison and Olive Shaw end at the APCM but both are eligible for nomination.

Parochial Church Council: nominations for THREE members of the PCC

Each member elected will serve for a period of THREE years]

The terms of office of Katy Stanton and Sheila McMillan end at this year's APCM but both are eligible for nomination.

The Parochial Church Council is a Registered Charity with its members as Trustees. Those nominated for any of these posts must not be debarred from acting as a Charity Trustee.

Nominees must have been on the Parish Electoral Roll for six months before the election [Rule M8(c)]

Assistant Churchwardens: nominations invited

The Assistant Wardens are part of the team of key-holders for the Church and Church Hall and are intended to assist the Churchwardens.

They act as Duty Warden at our services and events, to open the Church or Hall as appropriate and ensure that the buildings are safe and secure.

Faith read Genesis 12: 1-4

Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness

[Romans 4: 3; Genesis 15: 6]

In Genesis Chapter 11 we find Abram's family tree linking him back to Shem, one of the sons of Noah. Abram's father, Terah, lived in Ur of the Chaldees, in modern day Iraq. He decided to move his family to Canaan but only reached Harran [southern Turkey] where they settled.

It was here that Abram received the call from the LORD to go to 'the land I will Show you' [Genesis 12: 1]. The promise associated with this call to Abram was that Abram would become a great nation. [12: 2]

In faith Abram obeyed the call and set off with his wife Sarai, his nephew Lot and all their possessions. The journey took them to Canaan where their first step was to build an altar to the Lord at Shechem. This was as a response to the further promise from the Lord that this land would be given to Abram's descendants [12: 7]. A second altar to the Lord was erected at Bethel before Abram moved to the Negev. One of the frequent famines in the area forced Abram further south into Egypt.

Abram became very wealthy in Egypt and eventually returned to Bethel and Canaan before settling in Hebron. [13: 3, 18]

It was to be some time before the next phase of the promise was realised. Abram and Sarai were childless but in a re-affirmation of the Covenant, Abraham and Sarai were renamed by the LORD to Abraham and Sarah [17: 5, 15]. The first result came when they were promised a son [18: 10]. This promise was duly fulfilled when Sarah gave birth to Isaac. [21: 2]. Abraham's faith led to Isaac and Jacob. The twelve sons of Jacob were the founders of the 12 tribes of Israel in Egypt. The Israelites were led out of Egypt and eventually back to Canaan, the Promised Land. The Lord's promise to Abraham came to fruition through faith.
