**Focus on the Apostles:** 

Barnabas, Son of Encouragement: 11th June

O LORD God Almighty, who didst endue thy holy Apostle Barnabas with singular gifts of the Holy Ghost: Leave us not, we beseech thee, destitute of thy manifold gifts, nor yet of grace to use them alway to thy honour and glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen. [BCP]

We first meet Joseph, a Levite and native of Cyprus, when he brings the proceeds from the sale of his field to the Apostles at a time when the "company of those who believed" had everything in common. The Apostles gave him the name Barnabas which means Son of Encouragement. We are also told that there was not a needy person among them because of the generosity of Barnabas and others in the group. [Acts 4: 32- 37]

In subsequent chapters of the Acts of the Apostles we read of Saul of Tarsus [later St Paul] and his relentless persecution of the early church. Saul encounters the Risen Jesus on the road to Damascus, is converted and spends some time there proclaiming Jesus as the Son of God [Acts 9: 20]. Saul's preaching so incensed the Jews in Damascus that they plotted to kill him. Saul became aware of the plot and escaped in a basket over the city walls [Acts 9:22]

The disciples were suspicious of Saul when he tried to join them in Jerusalem. Barnabas was the one who took the time to meet Saul, bring him to the Apostles and convince them of his conversion.

Some of the believers had escaped the persecutions in Jerusalem and had moved to Antioch, one of the larger cities in the then Roman Empire. They continued to preach with great success. The Apostles heard of this and sent Barnabas to Antioch. Barnabas fetched Saul and they spent a year in Antioch teaching a large company of people and it was here that they were first called Christians.

Barnabas and Paul [the Roman form of Saul] were sent out by the Church at Antioch on a missionary journey, first to Cyprus and then Galatia before returning to Antioch. A proposed return visit to the area caused friction between Paul and Barnabas over the inclusion of John Mark who had been on the previous Journey but had returned early to Jerusalem. The two went their separate ways with Barnabas returning to Cyprus with John Mark. [Acts 15: 36-41].

We take our leave of Barnabas with the description of him whilst at Antioch as

"a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith" [Acts 11: 24]
