Haggai - The time is right...

We know little about the Prophet Haggai except for four very specific dates within a four month period in 520 BC when his prophesies were revealed [Haggai 1: 1; 2: 1; 2:10; 2:20]. He may have been among the original exiles but his message from the Lord is very specific but unusual when compared to other Prophets—the people listened!

The Israelites had returned to Jerusalem from their exile in Babylon around 538 BC. King Cyrus of Persia had given permission for the re-building of the city and the Temple to commence but his successors, Xerxes and Artaxerxes reversed that decision. Their advisors had warned that the re-establishment of the Temple and Jerusalem would make the Israelites a greater threat to the safety of the Persian Kingdom. [Ezra 4: 11-24].

The work on the Temple, which had started with an outpouring of praise to the Lord and great joy from the peoples [Ezra 3: 10] came to an abrupt stop. In the succeeding years, the Israelites faced hardships brought upon them by the Lord primarily because of their lack of attention to the Temple despite building their own houses. [Haggai 1: 6; 9-11]

Some 18 or so years later, in the second year of the reign of King Darius of Persia, the time was right. Haggai's prophecy was directed to Zerubbabel, son of Shealtiel, Governor of Judah, and to Joshua, son of Jozadak, the High Priest. The prophesy was simple – **rebuild the Temple or else the hardships will continue.**

For once the prophecy was acted on by the people and the Temple was completed over the next four years. Known as the Second Temple, it was set to remain as the centre of their religious life for nearly six centuries until destroyed by the Romans in 70 AD as revenge for continuing revolts against Roman rule and would have been familiar to Jesus.

With the completion of the Temple the Lord renewed his Covenant with the Israelites

'From this day on I will bless you.' [Haggai 2: 19]
