What's in a Book? Psalms

The Book of Psalms is a collection of songs and poems that represent centuries worth of praise and prayers to God with a variety of themes for all circumstances. Many of the one hundred and fifty separate psalms are attributed to King David with others to Asaph, the sons of Korah, Solomon and other writers. The name derives from the Greek word ψαλμοί (*psalmoi*) which means instrumental music and their accompanying words. Psalm 119 is the longest psalm with 176 verses while psalm 117 is the shortest with only two verses. Some psalms are better known than others. How many of these do you know and can you
