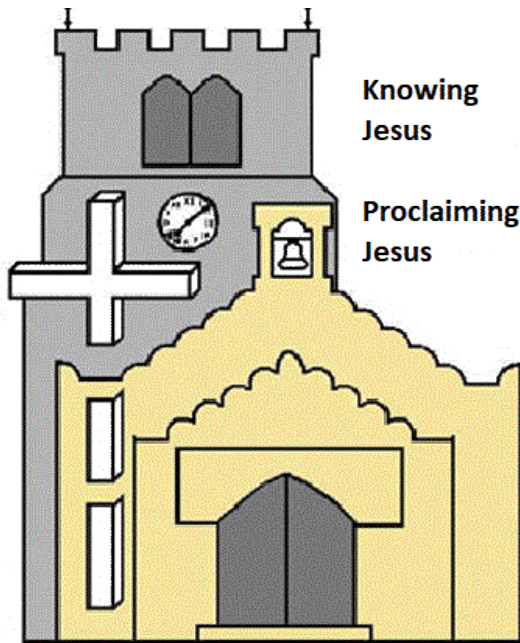

Hannah

Hannah was the wife of Elkanah from the hill country of Ephraim. Elkanah regularly, year by year, made the journey to Shiloh to worship and sacrifice to the LORD. [1 Samuel 1: 1-3] Elkanah's other wife, Peninnah had children, but Hannah had none. On one of their visits, Hannah fervently prayed for a son and promised to 'give him to the Lord for all the days of his life.' [1 Samuel 1: 10-11] Eli, the Priest saw Hannah and thought that she was drunk because of the deep emotions she was showing in her prayers. After explaining her actions, Hannah received a blessing from Eli. The LORD heard her prayer and in due time she bore a son who she named Samuel "because I asked the Lord for him" [1 Samuel 1: 20]. On a later visit, when Samuel was old enough Hannah brought Samuel and left him with Eli where he ministered to the Lord and grew in stature and in favour with the LORD and with people. [1 Samuel 2: 26].
